## **FOREWORD**

This volume contains extended abstracts of the invited and contributed papers to be presented at the International Conference on Hydrology and Water Resources to be held on December 20-22,1993, in New Delhi, India. This conference is being held in honour of Professor S. Chandra who has had a long and distinguished career in hydrologic education, research and administration in India.
