## PREFACE

The Indian National Committee on Hydrology (INCOH) is an apex body, costituted by the Ministry of Water Resources in the year 1982 with its responsibility to coordinate various activities concerning hydrology in the country. The committee periodically updates hydrological activities and brings out state of art.
